

## CMS Master Installation Instructions

Please follow these detailed step-by-step instructions:

### 1. Unzip the downloaded package.

### 2. Upload files.

Upload all the files to the web root directory using an FTP client.

This directory is usually called 'html\_docs', 'public\_html', 'html', 'www', 'htdocs' or something similar.

### 3. Change permissions to the following folders:

/htaccess – 644

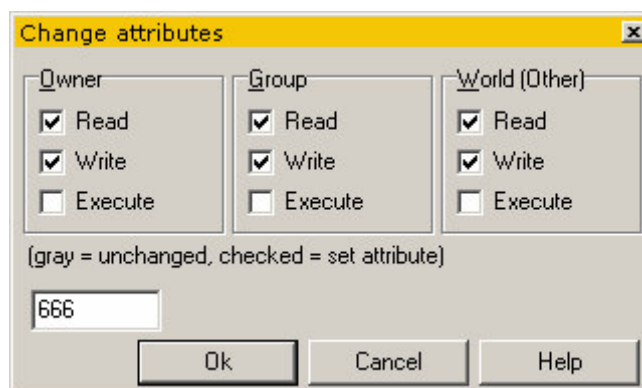
/cms-config.php – 644

/cms-files – 755

/cms-images – 755

/cms-pages – 755

/cms-pages/0 – 644



### 4. Web-based installation.

Open your web browser and paste the following address to the browser address bar to start CMS Master installation:

<http://YourDomain.com/cms-install>

**Note:** replace 'YourDomain' with the name of your website domain, e.g.

<http://www.cms-master.com/cms-install>

You will see the list of installed components. Click  to install CMS Master.

## 5. Read the License Agreement

Read the License Agreement and click 'Accept' if you agree to the terms. You will be redirected to the setup form.

## 6. Complete the setup form:

DB server:	<input type="text" value="localhost"/>
DB name:	<input type="text"/>
DB user:	<input type="text"/>
DB password:	<input type="password"/>
Administrator password:	<input type="password"/>
Retype password:	<input type="password"/>
Administrator email:	<input type="text"/>
<input type="button" value="Install"/>	

If you don't have a database, please contact your hosting provider and ask them to create the database for you. You will need the following information: database name, login name and password.

## 7. Check the settings.

The system will check write permissions to the following files and folders:

/.htaccess  
/cms-config.php  
/cms-images  
/cms-files  
/cms-pages

The system will also check your database settings.

Check write access to /.htaccess	<b>Done</b>
Check write access to /cms-config.php	<b>Done</b>
Check write access to folder /cms-images	<b>Done</b>
Check write access to folder /cms-files	<b>Done</b>
Check write access to folder /cms-pages	<b>Done</b>
Check database	<b>Done</b>
<input type="button" value="Login"/>	

If all the settings are correct, the installation will complete successfully and you will see the 'Login' button.

Otherwise you will see what steps were not successfully completed. In this case click 'Back' and check your settings.

#### **8. Login to Admin Area:**

**Login:** admin

**Password:** administrator password that you entered during installation.
