

## Template Customization

You can easily personalize your site design using CMS Master templates. They allow you to customize page layout, images, menu, colors, navigation links etc. You can edit template files with any text or HTML editor.

1. In order to modify template files, open **/cms-templates** directory where all template files are stored. This **/cms-templates** directory contains the file **base** (the template itself), **images** directory, and **module** directory.
2. In order to edit the page template, open the file **base** with any editor you use for editing html pages, and make necessary changes.

Tag description:

**CMS-PAGE-TITLE** – page title;  
**CMS-PAGE-DESCRIPTION** – page description;  
**CMS-PAGE-KEYWORDS** – page keywords;  
**CMS-MENU-1** – top-level horizontal menu;  
**CMS-MENU-2** – second-level vertical menu;  
**CMS-PAGE-CONTENT** – page content.

3. Upload necessary images to the **images** directory.  
**Note:** make sure that all images have full URL references.
4. All menu template files are stored in **/cms-templates/modules/menu** directory. The directory contains two files – menu1 and menu2.
5. In order to edit top-level horizontal menu, open the file **menu1**. In order to edit second-level vertical menu, open the file **menu2**.

Line 1 – start of menu  
Line 2 – inactive menu item  
Line 3 – active menu item  
Line 4 – end of menu  
Line 5 – no menu

**MENU\_NAME** is the name of the menu item;  
**MENU\_URL** is the page URL.
